Rite 13 Class-Tongues of Fire Chili Winners!



Rite 13 wanted to use a lamb-based chili because it reflects the time of Christ. They also wanted to have 13 seasonings to reflect the 13 in Rite 13. This recipe has the lamb, and it has 9 dried spices (with salt & pepper), 3 kinds of peppers, and cilantro--making 13 seasonings. The group added to ingredients according to taste.

Jesus Time Chili Recipe

- 2 medium onions, diced
 - 1 jalapeno pepper, diced, 1 green chili pepper diced, 1 poblano pepper, diced
 - 1.5 lb lean ground lamb, 0.5 lb lean ground beef
 - 4 chorizo sausages, casings removed
 - 6 garlic cloves, minced
 - 1 teaspoon red pepper flakes
 - 2 teaspoons dried oregano
 - 2 teaspoons cayenne
 - $\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon cinnamon, 1 teaspoon coriander
 - 8 tablespoons chili powder
 - 3 bay leaves
 - 1 (28 ounce) can diced tomatoes with juice
 - 1 (15 ounce) can diced tomatoes with juice
 - 1 (15 ounce) can tomato sauce
 - 1 (40.5 ounce) can red beans, rinsed and drained
 - 1 tablespoon salt, or more to taste - 2 teaspoons pepper, or more to taste
 - $\frac{1}{4}$ bunch fresh cilantro, minced
1. Coat a large, heavy-bottomed stock pot with spray oil and heat; cook onions, and peppers until onions are translucent,
 2. Add ground lamb, ground beef, and chorizo and cook over medium heat.
 3. When onions are soft and meat browned; drain well.
 4. Add garlic and season with red pepper flakes, oregano, cumin, cayenne, cinnamon, coriander, chili powder, bay leaf, and salt and pepper to taste.
 5. Sauté for 1 to 2 minutes.
 6. Add tomatoes and beans; bring to a boil.
 7. Reduce heat, simmer for 30 minutes.
 8. Add cilantro and simmer another 15 minutes.
